The EU and the U.S. governments have joined forces in (voluntary) policy and regulatory dialogues to address and find joint solutions to ongoing transatlantic issues such as climate change, inflation, energy, or digitalisation. The alliance of NGOs within the Transatlantic Consumer Dialogue (TACD) has stated that such cooperation should make markets fairer and safer, and that regulators can improve decision-making about health, environmental and digital policies on both sides of the Atlantic, but without impacting each other's freedoms to regulate in the public interest.

Join us on 27 June 2023 for our public forum, the first in-person post pandemic, to examine what this bilateral cooperation has achieved since its launch, and what it should focus on going forward to deliver concrete outcomes, in each of the areas covered.
